**Note 1:** All athletes, coaches, referees and officials from each member have to book their rooms with the organizer and have to stay in the official hotel during the *entire* period in attendance at the championship. Failure to comply to the rule mentioned above will have the effect that they will not receive accreditation and will not be permitted to compete or participate.

**Note 2:** The organizer will not be responsible for any hotel bills of the participating nations. Payment must be received at the above-mentioned bank account at the latest 7 days prior to the beginning of the Championship. All bank charges go at the expense of order party. If you choose the payment by bank transfer, you must inform the organizer in advance. All rooms must be booked at the latest with the deadline of the final nomination – 9th October 2024 is the latest date for any removal of nominated lifters, cancellation of booked hotel rooms or change in the number of ordered banquet tickets. If not cancelled in time, federations have to pay the reserved hotel rooms, the participation fee, the doping and the banquet tickets for all lifters and officials specified at the final nomination form.

#### Arrivals/Transportation:

Transport from Johannesburg International Airport to Potchefstroom is **55 EURO** one way, **110 EURO** Both ways. That includes all shuttle service between Venue and Hotel's. Payment will be in Cash/ or by bank transfer on arrival to the Meet Director.

#### Anti-Doping Information for the APF African Powerlifting Championships

- 1. You are <u>strictly liable</u> for any substance found in your body (or specimen). You may be charged with Anti-Doping rule violation for the presence or use of a prohibited substance or method, whether its use was intentional or not.
- 2. Always check your medications and supplements before consuming them to make sure they do not contain any substances or methods included on the <u>WADA Prohibited List</u>.
- 3. Educate yourself on the risks of <u>taking supplements</u> and minimize your risk.
- 4. All athletes **must** successfully complete education through the World Anti-Doping Agencies (WADA) online education platform (<u>Adel</u>) in order to be able to compete. You must submit your completed certificate from Adel with your nomination for your registration to be complete.
- 5. Understand and <u>educate</u> yourself on your <u>rights and responsibilities</u> as an athlete, including but not limited to:
  - i. requirements for submitting whereabouts information
  - ii. rights and responsibilities during sample collection
  - iii. responsibility to avoid the use of prohibited substances and methods
  - iv. consent to the use of your information
  - v. obligations to follow the <u>IPF Anti-Doping Rules</u> and all consequences deriving therefrom

All athletes participating at this event are classified as an International Level Athlete

As an International Level Athlete, if you have a medical condition for which you need to take a medication or use a therapeutic method that is prohibited under the WADA Prohibited List, apply for a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) to the appropriate organization (IPF or NADO) prior to the start of its use and at least 30 days before competing.

#### **Important Items to Remember**

Preliminary nomination forms must be sent not later than 60 days before the date of the Championship. Final nominations must be submitted no later than 21 days before the date of the Championship and must include only names from the preliminary nomination (i.e. only lifters from the preliminary nomination can be replaced by a substitute. No new nominations will be accepted).

According Technical Rules [Page 4, item 7] at the final nomination you must definitely list the athletes, who will take part in the championship. At the Technical meeting you can only delete athletes from your final nomination no more change by weight class of any athlete is possible. The final nomination is valid for the competition.

Victory Ceremonies will be held at the end of each lifting session. It will be mandatory that each athlete wear their National Team Warm-up/Track Suit for the award presentation.

If the organizer does not receive confirmed cancellations of hotel rooms at least 21 days prior to the championship, all hotel costs will be the responsibility of nominated lifters and officials. (IPF-By-Laws 12.9) The same applies to participation and anti-doping fees (IPF- By-Laws 14.5).

All athletes, coaches, referees or officials from each federation must stay in the official hotel during the entire time in attendance at the championship. If athletes, coaches, referees or officials do not stay in the official hotel during the championship. Failure to comply will have the effect that they will not receive accreditation and will be excluded from that championship (IPF By-laws 14.4).

**Indemnity & Insurance:** All participating federations and its delegated athletes and officials agree to indemnity and not hold the organizing committee accountable for and against any claims for personal injury, financial loss, death or property damage, in any form, arising out of or in any way resulting from the participation in, postponement or cancellation of the said World Championships.
